Part 1: The Heart Of Attraction Song of Songs 1:1-2:7 NIV

Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth—for your love is more delightful than wine.

Song of Songs 1:2

1. LASTING ATTRACTION INVOLVES CHARACTER.

She: ³ Pleasing is the fragrance of your perfumes; your name is like perfume poured out. No wonder the young women love you! ⁴ Take me away with you—let us hurry! Let the king bring me into his chambers.

Friends: We rejoice and delight in you; we will praise your love more than wine. Ch. 1:2-4

2. LASTING ATTRACTION INVOLVES CONFIDENCE.

She: ⁵ Dark am I, yet lovely, daughters of Jerusalem, dark like the tents of Kedar, like the tent curtains of Solomon. ⁶ Do not stare at me because I am dark, because I am darkened by the sun. My mother's sons were angry with me and made me take care of the vineyards; my own vineyard I had to neglect. ⁷ Tell me, you whom I love, where you graze your flock and where you rest your sheep at midday. Why should I be like a veiled woman beside the flocks of your friends?

3. LASTING ATTRACTION INVOLVES CONSIDERATION.

He: I liken you, my darling, to a mare among Pharaoh's chariot horses. Ch. 1:9

She: ¹³ My beloved is to me a sachet of myrrh resting between my breasts. ¹⁴ My beloved is to me a cluster of henna blossoms from the vineyards of En Gedi.

He: The beams of our house are cedars; our rafters are firs. Ch 1:17

4. LASTING ATTRACTION INVOLVES CAREFULNESS.

She: ⁴Let him lead me to the banquet hall, and let his banner over me be love.
⁵ Strengthen me with raisins, refresh me with apples, for I am faint with love.
⁶ His left arm is under my head, and his right arm embraces me.
